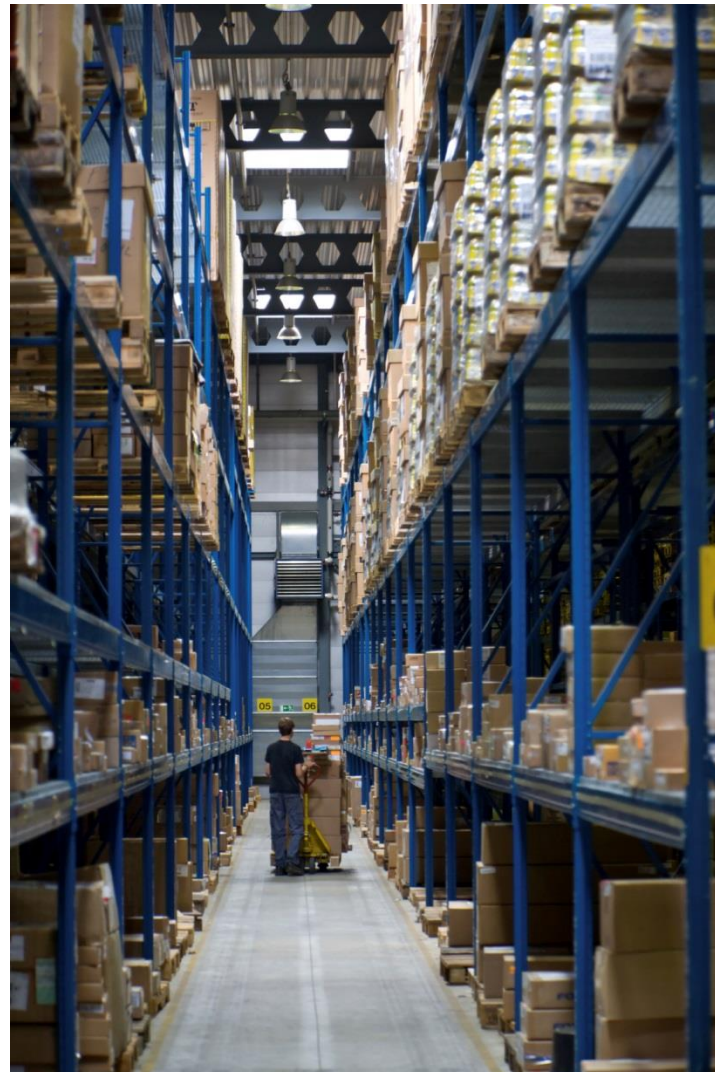

* Through 1Q; GDP forecast

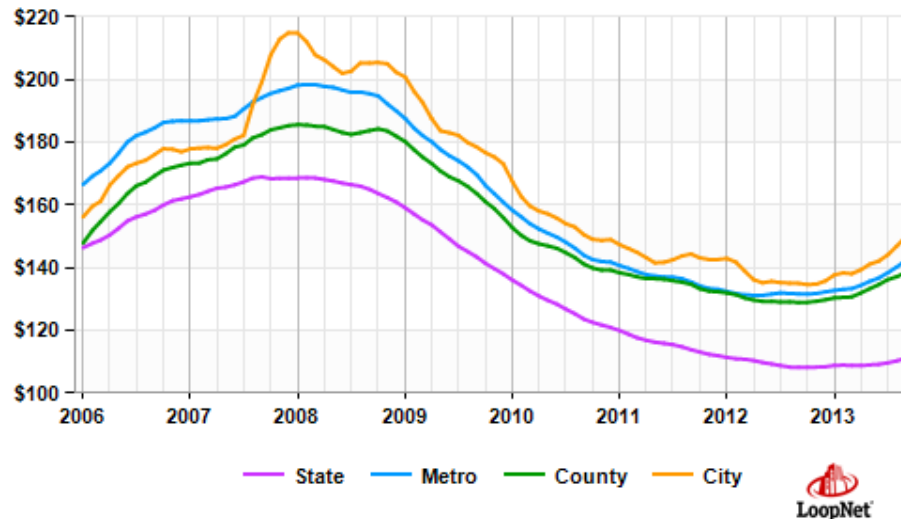

Maximizing your current space – the case for staying put

Fourteen consecutive quarters of declining vacancies in the warehouse sector highlight the U.S. industrial real estate market's momentum through the third quarter of 2013, according to Cushman & Wakefield.

This performance contributed to the nation's overall vacancy rate falling to 7.8 percent in the third quarter, down 70 basis points from a year ago and 300 basis points lower from its recent peak in first quarter 2010.

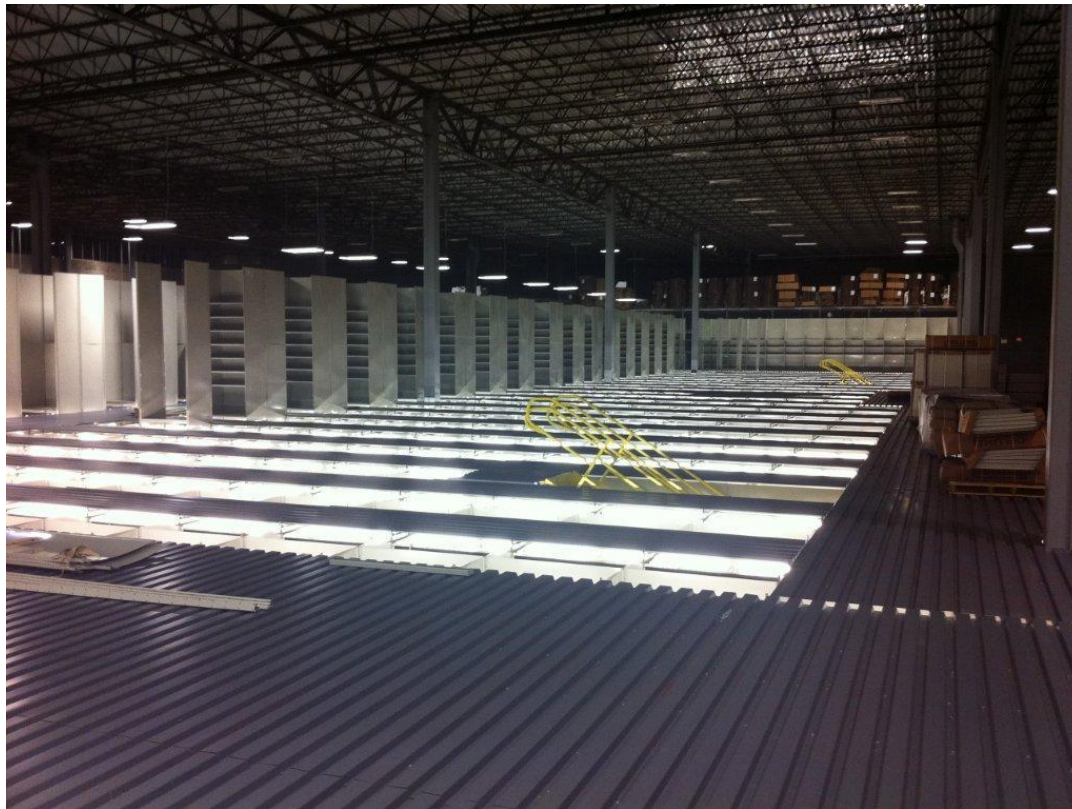
Case study: Four-level pick mod structure

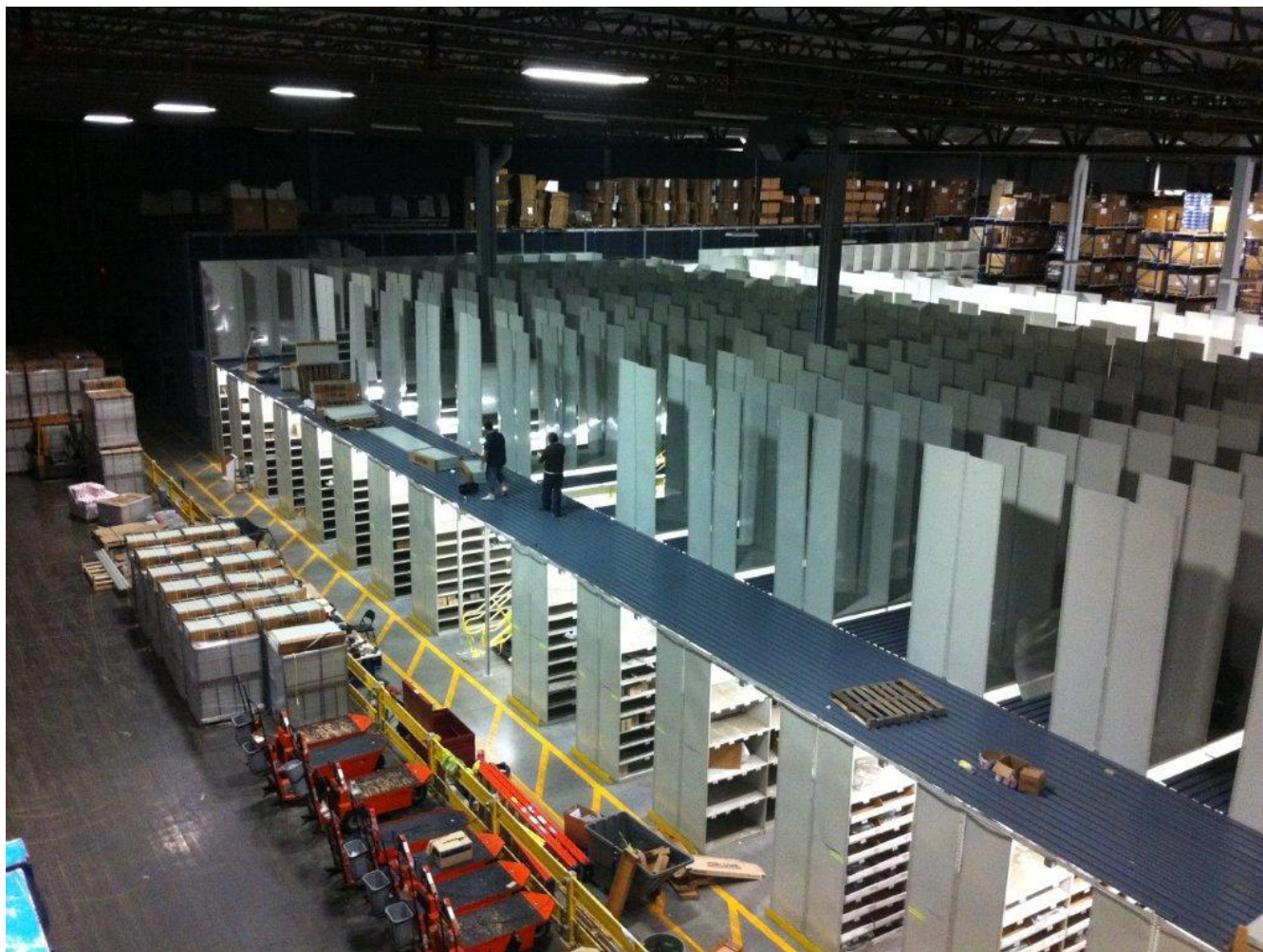
